Late registrations

All registrations/changes must be made in the Show Office no later than 18.00 the day before the class starts. Start lists will be published 2-3 hours before the start of the class, but an exception, morning's classes starlists will be published the night before.

Payment

Make sure you have an account number available after the end of the competition and we will transfer the money no later than 15 days after the end of the competition. For riders who are not resident in Sweden, 15% of tax is deducted on prize money.

Refund

In case of illness or an unwell horse, we must receive a medical certificate/veterinary certificate by the 18th September, and 100% of the paid entry fee will be refunded. No other fees, such as stall, veterinary fee, or office charge, will be reimbursed.

NOTE! Riders, owners, and the horse's NRHA papers must be submitted to the show office before the horse's first start! NO horse is allowed to compete if all paperwork is not in order. No exceptions! Each competitor is responsible for their own safety, as well as the safety of their horse and equipment at the competition venue.

Award Ceremony

The top 3 placements are requested to participate in the victory ceremony dressed in show attire and with their horse. Show respect for your fellow competitors and our sponsors. The placements from each class will be announced and available on the live score on the website Showmanager.info.

Monitor

There will be no monitor/livestream in the warm-up riding arena; instead, it will be available in the warm-up area at the competition arena. Feel free to stop and watch your ride, but please make way for the next competitor afterwards.

Video

RHV Video will livestream the entire competition, and video of your own ride can be obtained by contacting RHV Video during the event or by sending an email with your back number to: info@rh-video.de.



Veterinary inspection

Veterinary inspection takes place at the designated location from 07:00 AM to 09:00 AM on Thursday, and from 07:00 AM to 08:00 AM from Friday to Sunday. Participants in the first class have priority IF they are present at 07:00 AM. *NOTE! All horses must be inspected by a veterinarian every competition day. Inspection times will be communicated. All horses must be vaccinated against influenza. The basic vaccination consists of three vaccinations (A+B+C) with an interval of 20–60 days between A and B.

After the B-vaccination, the horse is eligible to compete. The interval between B- and C-vaccination is 120–180 days. After the C-vaccination, the horse remains eligible to compete. Subsequently, the horse must be revaccinated (R) within 365 days to maintain eligibility. To compete, at least seven days must have passed since the last vaccination (B, C, and R). For example, if the horse is vaccinated on a Thursday, it can compete the following Friday. The change in the interval does not affect vaccinations administered before January 1, 2024.

Ethical Rules

The correct number must be visibly worn during riding and lunging. The horse's passport must be brought to the competition and should be able to be presented during veterinary inspection or upon request. Horses must be vaccinated against equine influenza. Youth riders (under 18 years) must wear a helmet during all riding activities.

Violent riding/handling of horses in the competition area and riding horses showing lameness or signs of illness will result in disqualification from the competition without refund!

Responsibility

The organizer disclaims responsibility for damages to horses, riders, third parties, or equipment during the competition.

Reservations

We reserve the right to adjust prices outside TLReining Shows and NRHA Sweden's control. The exchange rate we apply is set by NRHA and can be found on NRHA's website. We reserve the right to make changes to the class order mandated by few or many competitors! The competition may be canceled in case of contagious diseases and/or due to external factors beyond TLReining Shows and NRHA Sweden's control.
