Late entries for classes during the show:

All late entries/changes must be reported to the show office no later than 6:00 PM the day before class starts.

Entries for Paid Warm Up must be done via Showmanager and are not accepted on site.

Arrival

No earlier than 12.00 AM on Wednesday 16 April. The stalls are not available before then.

Drawlists

All drawlists are published on showmanager and assigned to the show office and the warm up area. Drawlists for classes that run in the morning are published the night before and drawlists for classes that run in the afternoon are published during the morning of the day in question.



Award ceremonies

Top 3 are requested to attend the award ceremonies in show clothes and with their horses. Show respect for your fellow competitors and our sponsors.

The placings from each class will be announced by the speaker and are available at Showmanager.

Payouts

Give your account number to the show office before you leave the showground. Prize money is paid out no later than 15 days after the show. For participants who do not reside in Sweden, 15% tax is deducted on prize money.

Refunds

Refund of class fees can be done if you show a sickness certificate for riders or a veterinary certificate for horses. The certificates must be available to the show office no later than the last day of the show.

Only class fees will be refunded. No other show fees!

You will not be allowed to show without a valid license/membership in NRHA/NRHA Sweden.

Monitor

There will be a monitor/livestream in the warm up area. You are welcome to stop and watch your ride, but remember to leave room for participants that have not yet shown.

Veterinary inspection

Veterinary inspection will take place at designated place and time. These will be published in the competition group on Facebook.

All horses must be inspected in the morning if they are to be shown during that day.

Participants in the first class of the day have priority if they are present when the inspection begins.

All horses must be vaccinated against influenza.

Basic vaccination involves three vaccinations (A+B+C) with an interval of 20–60 days between A and B. After the B vaccination, the horse is eligible to start. The interval between the B and C vaccinations is 120–180 days. After the C vaccination, the horse is still eligible to start. The horse must then be vaccinated within 365 days to be eligible to start. In order to start, at least seven days must have passed since the last vaccination.

**Ethical rules**

Correct backnumber must be worn visibly when riding and lunging on the showgrounds.

The horse's passport must be brought to the show and must be shown during veterinary inspection or upon request.

The horses must be vaccinated against equine influenza.

Youth riders (under 18) must wear a helmet during all riding activities.

Violent riding/handling of the horses on the show grounds and riding horses showing lameness or signs of illness will result in disqualification from the show without refund!

Responsibility

The show organizer disclaims responsibility for any damage to horse, rider, third party or equipment during the show. Own insurance applies.

Safety

Each competitor is responsible for the safety of himself, his horse and equipment at the competition site.

Reservation

We reserve the right to adjust prices if something happens beyond the organizer's control.

The exchange rate we apply is set by NRHA and can be found on NRHA's website.

We reserve the right to change the class order in case of fewer or more participants.

The show can be canceled in case of contagious diseases and/or due to external factors beyond the organizers control.
